The Biblical injustice of American slavery comes down to two things, working in tandem: its permanence (complete legal barriers to manumission) and its purely racial basis. Even ancient Hebrew slaves enjoyed periodic jubilee. Certainly New Testament slaves had various means to earn their freedom, depending on context. This much can be said: God never permits His people to use slavery as a means of permanent exploitation, the gluttonous feeding off of others and their children, generation after generation.
